In response to “The Reconstruction of Relationships in Grief Work Processes (1),” we particularly paid attention to a young generation in its 10’s and 20’s who showed a change in “his or her way of life” when reconstructing relationships. The bereavement and human relations have an influence on the way of life in young people who are sensitive to those in particular. A young people think about the way of life of oneself and also seize opportunities which are not necessarily obtained from the relations from living human beings. Reconstructing relationships with the deceased in the course of an experience of losing someone and going after the process of grief work have great influences. In this study, we present two adolescent case studies that found their way of life by experiencing loss of someone and reconstructing human relationships, and organized specific processes of the reconstructing relationship.
